

## **SESSION 6 - THE EARLY CHURCH**

### 1. \_\_\_\_\_: The Early Conflict (Acts 15:1-21)

**15** But some men came down from Judea and were teaching the brothers, "Unless you are circumcised according to the custom of Moses, you cannot be saved."...<sup>7</sup> And after there had been much debate, Peter stood up and said to them, "Brothers, you know that in the early days God made a choice among you, that by my mouth the Gentiles should hear the word of the gospel and believe. <sup>8</sup> And God, who knows the heart, **bore witness** to them, by **giving them the Holy Spirit** just as he did to us, <sup>9</sup> and he **made no distinction** between us and them, having **cleansed their hearts by faith**. <sup>10</sup> Now, therefore, why are you putting God to the test by **placing a yoke on the neck of the disciples that neither our fathers nor we have been able to bear?** <sup>11</sup> **But we believe that we will be saved through the grace of the Lord Jesus, just as they will."**

# 2. THE SEQUEL: "Not \_\_\_\_\_\_ with the truth of the \_\_\_\_\_\_" (Gal 2:7-14)

<sup>11</sup> But when Cephas came to Antioch, I opposed him to his face, because he stood condemned. <sup>12</sup> For before certain men came from James, **he was eating with the Gentiles; but when they came he drew back and separated himself, fearing the circumcision party**. <sup>13</sup> And the rest of the Jews acted hypocritically along with him, so that **even Barnabas** was led astray by their hypocrisy. <sup>14</sup> But when **I saw that their conduct was not in step with the truth of the gospel**, I said to Cephas before them all, "If you, though a Jew, live like a Gentile and not like a Jew, how can you force the Gentiles to live like Jews?"

<sup>15</sup> We ourselves are Jews by birth and not Gentile sinners; <sup>16</sup> yet we know that a person is <b>not justified by</b> <b>works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ</b> , so we also <b>have believed</b> in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified <b>by faith</b> in Christ and <b>not by works</b> of the law, because <b>by works of the law no one will be</b> <b>justified.</b> <sup>21</sup> I do not nullify the <b>grace of God</b> , for if righteousness were through the law, then Christ died for no purpose.

<sup>7</sup> Know then that it is <b>those of faith</b> who are the <b>sons of Abraham</b> . <sup>8</sup> And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles <b>by faith</b> , preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed." <sup>9</sup> So then, <b>those who are of faith</b> are blessed along with Abraham, <b>the man of faith</b> .

#### (Gal 3:10-14)

<sup>10</sup> For all who rely on works of the law are under a curse; for it is written, "**Cursed be everyone who does not abide by all things written in the Book of the Law, and do them**."... <sup>13</sup> Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law **by becoming a curse for us**—for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree"— <sup>14</sup> so that in Christ Jesus the **blessing of Abraham** might come to the Gentiles, so that we might receive the **promised Spirit through faith**.

## 6. THE \_\_\_\_\_: \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_

## (Gal 3:15-24)

<sup>21</sup> Is the law then contrary to the promises of God? Certainly not! For if a law had been given that could give life, then righteousness would indeed be by the law. <sup>22</sup> **But the Scripture imprisoned everything under sin**, <u>so that</u> the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe.

<sup>23</sup> Now before faith came, we were held captive under the law, imprisoned until the coming faith would be revealed. <sup>24</sup> So then, **the law was our guardian until Christ came**, <u>in order</u> that we might be justified by faith. Gal 3:21-24

## 7. SONS OF \_\_\_\_\_: \_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ by his Spirit (Gal 3:25 – 4:7)

<sup>4</sup> But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, <sup>5</sup> to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might **receive adoption as sons**. <sup>6</sup> And because you are sons, **God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"** <sup>7</sup> So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.

### 8. \_\_\_\_\_: New Covenant reality

### (Gal 4:8-31)

<sup>31</sup>So, brothers, we are not children of the slave but of the free woman.

## 9. CIRCUMCISION AS \_\_\_\_\_: \_\_\_\_\_ from Christ

## (Gal 5:1-12)

For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a **yoke of slavery**.

<sup>2</sup>Look: I, Paul, say to you that **if you accept circumcision**, **Christ will be of no advantage to you**. <sup>3</sup>I testify again to every man who accepts circumcision that he is **obligated to keep the whole law**. <sup>4</sup>You are **severed from Christ**, you who would be justified by the law; you have fallen away from grace. <sup>5</sup>For through the Spirit, by faith, we ourselves eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness. <sup>6</sup>For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only faith working through love.

## 10. LAW OF \_\_\_\_\_: Fulfilled by walking \_\_\_\_\_ with the \_\_\_\_\_ (Gal 5:13 - 6:10)

<sup>14</sup> For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." ... <sup>16</sup> But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh....<sup>25</sup> If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit ...<sup>2</sup> Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ...
